

Solution WS 4 - Conditional sentences type III

What could they have done to get things right? Make conditional sentences (type III)

1. Julie forgot to call her grandma on her birthday.

If – write – the date into her calendar – remember it.

If Julie had written the date into her calendar, she would have remembered it.

2. Jacob didn't have time to buy bread for the family.

If – not talk – with his friend Henry – have time to buy it.

If Jacob hadn't talked with his friend Henry, he would have had time to buy it.

3. The Connors missed their train.

If – take a taxi – catch the train.

If they had taken a taxi, they would have caught the train.

4. I was late for my job interview.

If – get up earlier – not be late for my job interview.

If I had gotten up earlier, I wouldn't have been late for my job interview.

5. Kate got a terrible cold.

If – put on a raincoat – not get a cold.

If Kate had put on a raincoat, she wouldn't have got a cold.
