Comment:

The introduction to the article succeeds in presenting the problem that humans are acting selfish towards the environment. Even though I think the arguments are all valid I think they are presented in such a broad way and abundance that they somehow feel disingenuous. In the last part she writes about what a person could do to solve those environmental problems and I also think it has a similar issue. Importantly I think the ideas she proposes are still good but the way she presents them here isn't helpful in my opinion.
